

HEMP CULTIVATION SUPPLEMENT

Please fill out this supplement if you wish to certify hemp as organic. **Note:** *Additional forms and documents must be completed and accompany this supplement, including the Hemp Compliance Affidavit, Producer Information, Farm Plan, Materials List, Crops List, Landowner Affidavit (if applicable) and Field and Greenhouse histories.*

1) Licensing

a). Provide the license number and expiration date for hemp cultivation. Please submit your approved license application showing the growing area approved by the State of Maine for the license.

b). Provide the nursery license number and expiration date for hemp seedling production, if applicable.

3) Testing

3a) Include information from the Certificate of Analysis (COA) test results to demonstrate compliance with state and federal law. Attach COAs for each seed varietal purchased. Also attach COAs for each variety of hemp crop harvested during the previous season.

4. Post-Harvest Handling

4a) Describe your post-harvest handling procedures, including storage conditions for drying, curing and extracting. Briefly describe the full circle of harvest from drying to handling through to processing and sales below. An On-farm Processing supplement should be completed when processing hemp beyond curing. Final determination of required forms will be made by MCS.

4b) A facility diagram and a process flow description is required. Please attach.

A. Facility Diagram – Indicate all equipment locations and storage and processing areas. You may use this diagram to show locations of pest control traps/lights/lures.

B. Process Flowchart – Please indicate each production step from harvest to finished product.

4c) Describe your critical control points for humidity, sanitation and pest controls.

Please submit a Materials List with this supplement. Please see the Maine Board of Pesticides Control (BPC) list of approved pesticide products for hemp cultivation in Maine.
