**\*Title 7: Agriculture Part 205 – National Organic Program, Subpart B Applicability**

***§ 205.101 Exemptions and exclusions from certification.***

- (a) *Exemptions* (1) A production or handling operation that sells agricultural products as “organic” but whose gross annual income from organic sales totals \$5,000 or less is exempt from certification and from submitting an organic system plan for approval under §205.201 but must comply with the applicable organic production and handling requirements of subpart C and the labeling requirements of §205.310. **The products from such operations shall not be used as ingredients identified as organic in processed products produced by another handling operation**
